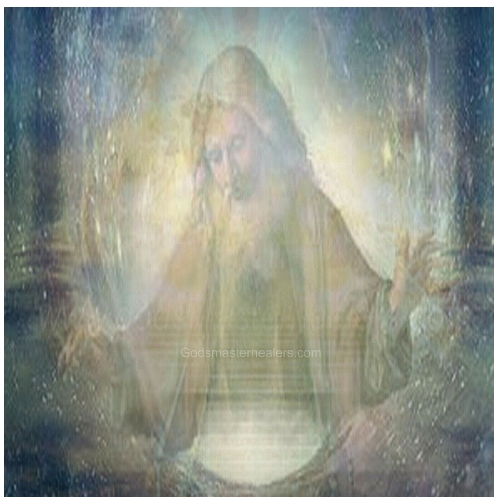
Economy Aura Glasses™
