Why do I have to work for an hour in order to afford 3 chicken tenders at this school? A good airfryer, brand new, costs about \$100₁ (and a serviceable one or used definitely less) also you could just straight up use your dorm oven. You can get about 24 raw chicken tenders (breaded) for \$6.99 at Kroger₂. So theoretically I could sell chicken tenders at a much lower price and still come out even.

Now the exact brand that Bon Appetit uses (most likely) to purchase chicken tenders is Gordon Food Services, where you can get 10 pounds of tenders for \$39.99₃. As per the back of a Tyson Foods chicken tenders box, the average tender weighs about $47g (1.7oz)_4$, for those of you at home that's around 9-10 a pound. Therefore, Bon Appetit is most likely getting around 95 chicken tenders for about \$40. This means that if each student is getting 3 tenders they can sell tenders to 32 students, at a price of roughly \$10 per student that is a profit of somewhere around \$280 (or \$8.75 per student). The price of fries and watered-down honey mustard must also be taken into account, but considering you can get 30lbs of fries for \$22₅ I doubt that would do much to offset profits.
