BULLSHEET 2024-25 SEASON: NEW MEMBERS

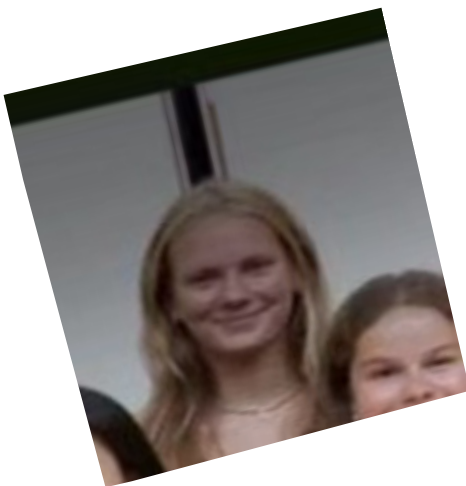
