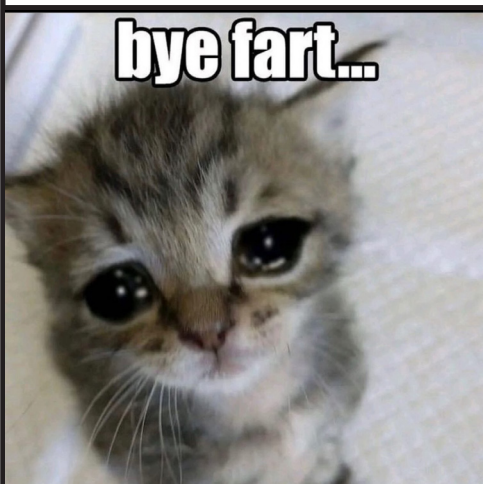
Who? Who is eating white chocolate? It's not me, it shouldn't be you, so let's cancel this fraud!
