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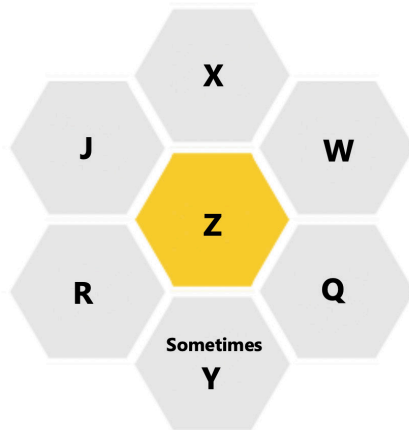

Sorry - You're not sorry.

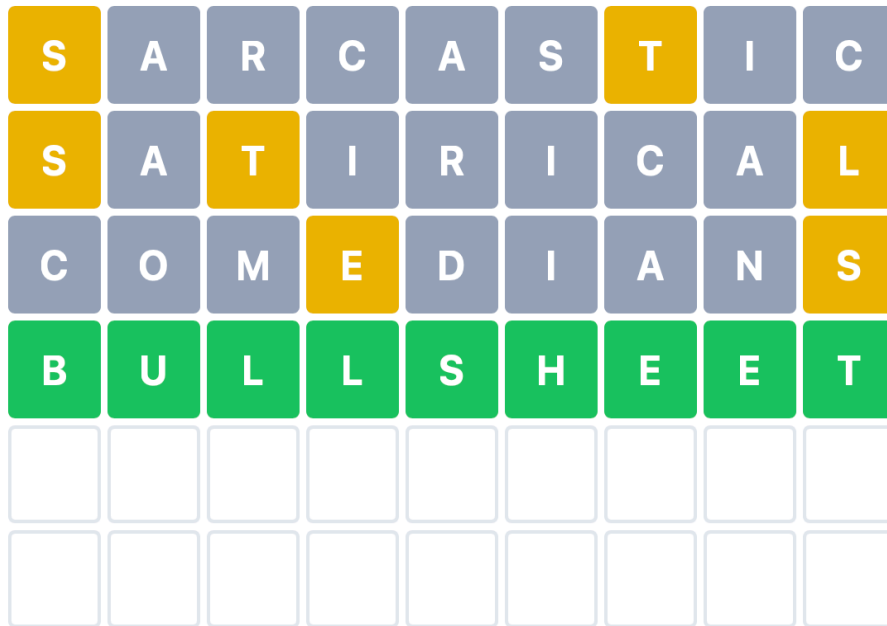
Uno - You should really be calling it "one." Spanish is not your first language (or second).
