You can expect a lot of new changes next fall, including:

No Mattresses

We are dedicated to promoting and enhancing academic and personal development, promoting community-building, increasing student engagement, and improving the overall campus life experience. That is why we are getting rid of mattresses. Incoming first-year students will now get twenty mattresses each and will undergo a princess-and-the-pea like trial.
